

RESOLUTION NO. 191

**A RESOLUTION OF THE PULASKI COUNTY REGIONAL SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT DISTRICT (District) BOARD TO UPDATE THE FEE ASSESSED PER TON OF NON-EXEMPT SOLID WASTE**

- Whereas,** The District Board has an overall responsibility to promote regional recycling; and,
- Whereas,** The District Board has determined in Policy Rule 4 and 5 (1992) and resolution 151 (2002) that fees on solid waste are necessary and beneficial to the citizens of the District to promote recycling; and,
- Whereas,** Act 209 of 2011 states that a District Board may assess a fee on each ton of solid waste generated within the District delivered to a transfer station or landfill within or outside the District or generated outside the District delivered to a landfill within the District for disposal; and,
- Whereas,** Act 209 of 2011 exempts from fees non-municipal solid waste generated by a private industry and delivered to its privately operated disposal facility or shipped out of state, steel mill solid waste, materials removed from solid waste and processed for recycling, organic materials that are composted, waste tires and household hazardous waste.

**Now: Therefore be it Resolved:**

- Section 1:** District Board hereby authorizes the District to levy a fee of (A) \$ 0.30 per ton on the non-exempt solid waste generated within the District and delivered to a transfer station or landfill within or outside the District for disposal and (B) \$ 2.00 per ton on the non-exempt solid waste generated outside the District and delivered to a landfill within the District for disposal.
- Section 2:** In accordance with Act 209 of 2011 the total fee per ton of non-exempt solid waste shall not exceed \$2.00 per ton.
- Section 3:** The District Board shall determine by interlocal agreement how the District will assess, administer and divide the non exempt solid waste fee not to exceed the \$2.00 per ton.
